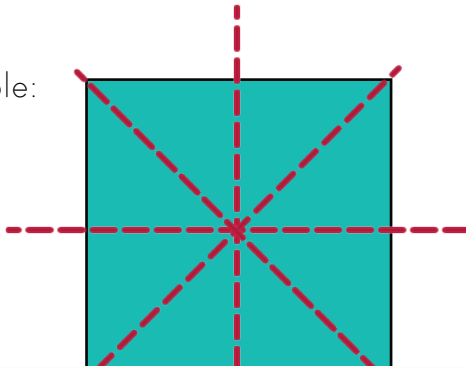


Line of Symmetry

A square has 4 lines of symmetry.

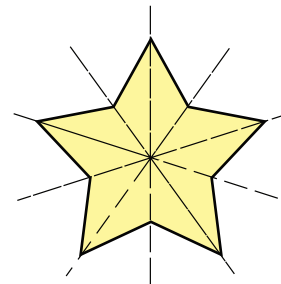
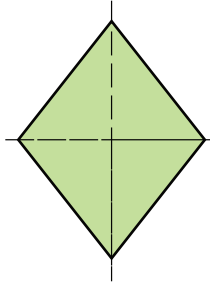
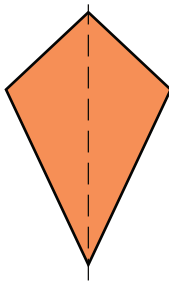

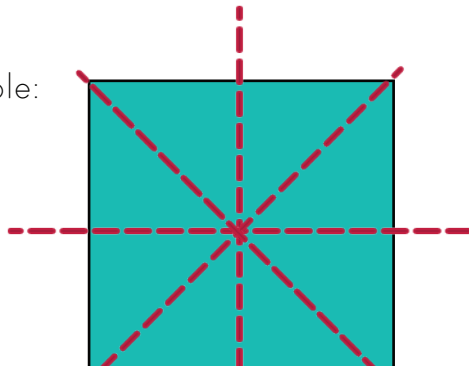
