

Where Animals Live Part 1

Read the passage below and answer the questions.

Animals live in many different places. Some animals like to live all alone. These animals are called "solitary." Other animals like to live together with their family or friends. These animals live in a "group." Let's learn about where some animals live!



Foxes are mostly solitary, but sometimes they live with their family. Foxes are clever animals that hunt small animals like rabbits.

Elephants live in groups called herds. They help each other find food and water. Elephants use their trunks to pick up food and talk to each other.

Bears are solitary and like to live alone in the forest or on the mountains. Bears eat berries, fish, and other animals.





Where Animals Live Part 2

Fish can live in groups called schools. Swimming together helps them stay safe. Fish have fins and tails to help them move quickly.

Ants live in big groups in their homes called colonies. They work together as a team. Ants carry food back to their nests to share with others.



Bees live in busy groups called hives. They work together to make honey. Bees fly from flower to flower to collect nectar.

Owls are usually solitary. They hunt alone at night. Owls have big eyes to help them see in the dark.

Lions live in groups called prides. They help each other stay safe and find food. Lions roar loudly to talk to other lions.
